

NEET'S ALL INDIA QUOTA



Issue

The NEET exam will have reservations for OBC and EWS (Economically Weaker Section) within the All-India quota.

Background

NEET is an All-India entrance examination for selecting candidates for medical and dental colleges across the country.

Details

- Admissions to all undergraduate (NEET-UG) and postgraduate (NEET-PG) courses in dental and medical streams are given through National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET).
- NEET was held for the first time in year 2003 but was scrapped later. Prior to second time implementation of NEET, All India Pre-Medical Test (AIPMT) was conducted.
- AIPMT was a national level entrance examination for medical courses. Every state had their own examination for filling the seats.
- Section 10-D of the Indian Medical Council Act, which gave birth to NEET, was upheld by the Supreme Court. It envisaged a uniform national level test.
- The test was to be conducted for both undergraduate and post-graduate courses for all medical educational institutions in English, Hindi and other languages.
- The NEET is currently conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) since 2018. Earlier, it was conducted by the CBSE.

The All India quota (AIQ)

- Currently, majority of seats in medical colleges are reserved for students residing in the same state. The remaining seats are surrendered for All India Quota.
- The All India Quota allows meritorious students from other states to study in any good medical colleges across the country.
- Candidates scoring high will ensure admission in a college under the national quota. If they fail to score higher, they can get seat under the state quota.

Current reservation

- There was no reservation in All-India quota till 2007. The Supreme Court had directed to implement 15% for Scheduled Castes and 7.5% for Scheduled Tribes.
- The quota for OBC was introduced in Central government institutions but not to the seats under AIQ in state institutions.
- The 10 percent reservation under the EWS quota was also implemented in central government institutions but was still unavailable for AIQ.
