## Early Registration for Resident Advisors

**Whereas:** Resident Advisors are currently ineligible to apply for early registration due to the rules set forth by the Office of the Registrar, which state that the applicant for early registration must work a minimum of 12 hours per week between 8am and 5pm on business days; and

**Whereas:** Resident Advisors of Texas A&M University work at least 21 hours outside of the typical 8 to 5 workday hours in addition to many unrecorded hours during the period of 8 am to 5 pm; and

**Whereas:** These hours greatly affect class schedules, study times, and grades; and

**Whereas:** A petition and coalition of Resident Advisor statements in favor of allowing early registration will be gathered, organized, and delivered to Don Carter, Chair of the Office of the Registrar and Mark Weichold, Chair of the Academic Operations Committee, in addition to a proposal outlining the benefits of such a change, by the RA Staff Council and other interested students.

**Resolved:** The Student Government Association supports that the Resident Advisors of Texas A&M University shall be given the opportunity to register for classes

during the University granted early registration period, in order to better organize their schedules.
